Gadot will once again be <u>'Wonder Woman'</u> in her own titled film to be released in 2017. Alpha1Media were VIP guests at the <u>Gala European and UK Premiere of 'Man of Steel'</u>, at No. 2 in the <u>A1Film List 2013</u>, at Odeon Leicester Square, London, UK on 12 June 2013 (the 75th anniversary

of the creation of Superman in 1938), meeting with actor Henry Cavill and director Zack Snyder.

The A1Film 2016 Best Original Screenplay is given for <u>'La La Land'</u> to American auteur, <u>Damien Chazelle</u>, who wrote and directed the film, which is No. 2 on the No. 9 on the <u>A1Film Top 10 List for 2016</u>, with his previous film as an auteur being the critically-acclaimed, <u>'Whiplash'</u>.

The A1Film 2016 Best Producer is given to American producer and President of Marvel Studios, <u>Kevin Feige</u>, for <u>'Captain America: Civil War'</u>, No 1 on the <u>A1Film Top 10 List for 2016</u>, who also has a second Marvel film in the Top 10 with <u>'Deadpool</u>' at No. 7.

The A1Film 2016 Best Director is given to Canadian auteur, <u>Denis Villeneuve</u> for <u>'Arrival'</u>, No. 3 on the <u>A1Film Top 10 List for 2016</u>. Villeneuve has also directed the critically-acclaimed <u>'Sicario'</u> and <u>'Prisoners'</u>.

The A1Film 2016 Best Foreign Picture is given to Indian producer <u>Vidhu Vinod Chopra</u> for the film, <u>'Wazir'</u>, starring Indian legendary actor, <u>Amitabh Bachchan</u>, No. 7 in the <u>A1Film Top 10 List for 2016</u>. Chopra also produced the film <u>'3 Idiots'</u> in 2012, which was critically-acclaimed and was the highest-grossing Bollywood film in history.

The A1Film 2015 Best Actor Award is given to American actor Viggo Mortensen for his lead role in the film, <u>'Captain Fantastic'</u>, No. 6 in the <u>A1Film Top 10 List for 2016</u>. <u>'Captain Fantastic'</u> focuses on homeschooling in the US, with Mortensen playing a widower in the film. He has had supporting roles in films such as <u>'Carlito's Way'</u> and <u>'Daylight'</u>.

The A1Film 2016 Best Actress Award is given to American actress <u>Amy Adams</u> leading role in '<u>Arrival</u>', No 3 on the <u>A1Film Top 10 List for 2016</u>. Five-times Oscar nominated Adams also appears as Lois Lane in '<u>Batman v Superman</u>: <u>Dawn of Justice</u>', No 9 on the A1Film Top 10 List for 2016.

The A1Film 2016 Best Picture is given to is given to American producer and President of Marvel Studios, <u>Kevin Feige</u>, for <u>'Captain America: Civil War'</u>, No 1 on the A1Film Top 10 List for 2016.

"Captain America: Civil War' leads our list for five reasons – the film being an exemplar superhero blockbuster which is critically and financially acclaimed, the cinematic inclusion of a new Spider-man, the character arcs and story, the comparison with the DC Universe's efforts and the prescient theme of 'civil war' in America," said Ms. Felce, official spokeswoman for Alpha1Media upon publication of the A1Film Top 10 List for 2016.
